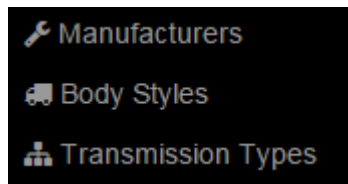


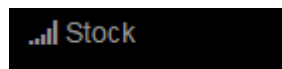
Adding stock




Prior to adding stock, please ensure the Manufacturer, Body Styles, and Transmission Types are set up; you do this click on the links in the Menu.

Now this is set up, we can continue with adding Stock.

Click the link for Stock



Click add new vehicle



Fill in the form with as much detail as possible, at the end there are two boxes for SEO, this is what Search engines see so please give some thought to what you will add here it can make a difference, **SEO Keywords need to be separated by a comma.**

Click add new vehicle at the foot of the page once you have added your information, you can always edit it a later time.

The page will refresh and you will see you new item in the list of items.

To Add Images

In order to allow as many images as you need / want I have split this section into a different set of files, to add images click on the Button inline with your new item,

This Page allows you to upload as many images as you require with just one input box! You can add multiple images in one go by selecting them all, please see below. To add multiple

images ...

1) Click "Browse"

2) Navigate to the folder with the images to upload

3) Select your first image, then press **Ctrl** and continue to hold as you select the rest of the images, when you have selected all your images release **Ctrl** then click OK / Open. Next to the browse button a count of how many images you have selected will appear. Click the Add Image(s) button to upload them.

Your uploaded images will appear in the lower half of your screen.

You are able to delete the images here also.

A word about images.

All images are resized upon upload, to around 700px wide x 500px tall, the script will intelligently resize to constrain proportions of the original.

Please ensure your uploaded images are large enough to be able to be resized.
